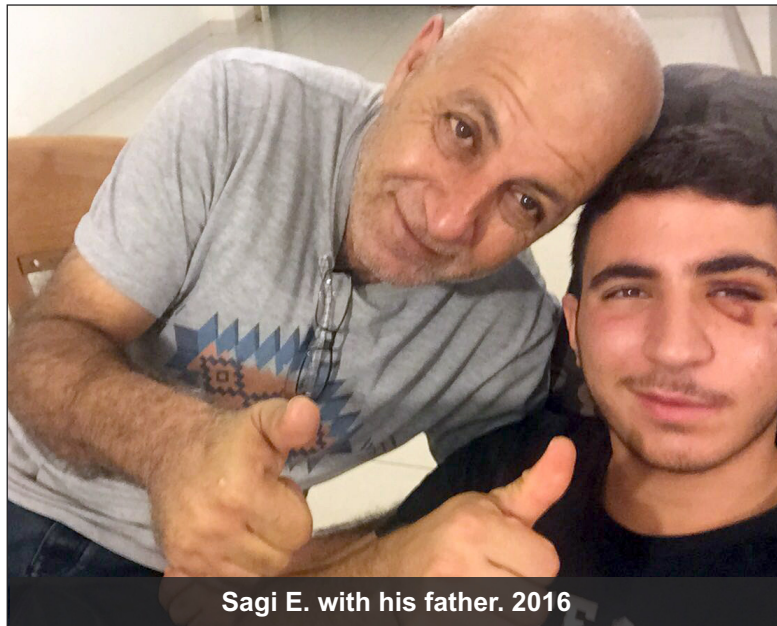


**54. Sagi E., 1995**, a border guard, was injured in battle with terrorists in the city of Ramalla in October 2015. He was wounded in his face by a stone.

Doctors put eight metal plates for the reconstruction of Sagi's face. Beside the physical injury, Sagi received a bad psychological trauma. He spent about three months at the hospital. After being discharged he continued rehabilitation at the local clinic in Tiberias.

Sagi was demobilized from the Army because of the post-traumatic disorder, but in May 2016 he still hadn't received even temporary disability.

Sagi has two younger siblings. His father works parttime on temporary jobs, mother works as a clerk. The family is struggling on mother's salary.

Sagi feels to be a burden on his family budget because he still doesn't receive his pension.
